

## BILATERAL AGREEMENT

Between

the **University of Cagliari**, based in Cagliari, via Università n. 40, C.F. 80019600925, on behalf of the University Rector, **Prof. Maria Del Zompo**, represented to the purpose of the signature of the present act by the Vice-Rector for International Affairs Prof. Alessandra Carucci, rectoral decrees. nn.704/15 and 809/15

And

the **Autonomous University of Coahuila**, based in Saltillo, Blvd. Venustiano Carranza sn, República Oriente, RFC: UAC730403446, on behalf of the University Rector, **Prof. Blas José Flores Dávila**.

### ASSUMING THAT:

both institutions have a cooperative relationship on the basis of a previously signed mutual agreement;

both institutions share and pursue international policies aimed to the creation of joint educational routes.

### IT IS AGREED AS FOLLOWS:

#### Article 1. Definition and Aims

By this Agreement, both Institutions intend to offer their students an experience of mobility that will allow them to stay at each Partner Institution for a period between three and twelve months.

During this time, exchange students will attend courses and lectures at the Host Institution, take (and pass) final examinations and/or carry out research for their bachelor thesis.

#### Article 2. Tutorship

For each exchange that will be carried out in accordance with this Agreement, the Sending Institution will nominate a member of staff who will be responsible for coordinating and overseeing didactic affairs concerning exchange students, in the following manner:

- a. by participating in the selection of the exchange students;
- b. by providing *outgoing students* with necessary information about the structure, function and organization of the Host Institution.

The Sending Institution will also nominate an administrative member of staff responsible for ensuring that the exchange program is properly applied and also provide *incoming students* with information on the Sending Institution itself.

### Article 3. Mobility threshold

Both Institutions have the power to determine the exchange units threshold. The Sending Institution has to communicate personal details of selected exchange students in reasonable time.

### Article 4. Rights and duties of the students

Once back, exchange students must hand the transcript of records to their home university, so that the credits they have acquired during the exchange program may be recognized.

The students partaking in the exchange will be subject to and must abide by all the rules and regulations of the host institution.

The exchange students will be required to meet necessary fees for their stay and their travel, unless other resources are made available.

If asked, students shall pay for any additional services provided by the Host Institution.

### Article 5. Duties of the Host Institution

The Host Institution will enrol incoming students as *foreign visiting students* for all the period of stay. The Host Institution will also provide visiting students with tuition fee waivers.

At the end of the exchange program, the Host Institution must provide visiting students with a *transcript of records*, so that their academic work can be valued and acknowledged at their home institution (see art. 4, 1st paragraph).

### Article 6. Duties of the sending institution (home university)

The Home University will examine and decide on the students applications, valuing if applicants' skills are consistent with the didactic contents of the exchange program.

The Home University shall also control and validate the credits the students have gained during the period of mobility.

### Article 7. Validity and Effectiveness


This Agreement will have a duration of two years from the date in which it is signed, and may be renewed by both parties.

At the end of each year, both institutions shall control the status of accomplishment of this Agreement.

Each institution may withdraw from this Agreement by giving the other institution at least ninety days advance written notice of its intention to terminate.

Unprejudiced the effects of the activities of mobility which are currently valid.


